



Infant Formula Notification Letter

Complete this form only if your child is under one year old

All children enrolled at Renaissance, including infants, are eligible for meals through the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) Child and Adult Care Food Program (CACFP). All child care centers in the program are partially reimbursed to help with the cost of serving nutritious meals to enrolled children. The meals must meet CACFP nutrition guidelines for children and infants. To meet the CACFP requirements this center will provide formula and other foods for infants. Renaissance supplies *Parent's Choice Milk-Based and Iron Fortified* Formula.

You may decide to bring your own formula and other infant foods. The center will claim reimbursement for your infant's meals when a meal contains only breast milk or infant formula, regardless of whom supplies the formula, and at least one food component of a meal is provided by the center when the infant is developmentally ready for semi-solid foods. As always, the center will introduce semi-solid foods when your family and/or pediatrician deems them appropriate.
